The Chicago Golf Tournament has a legacy of generosity

In 2016, the proceeds of the Partnership's Chicago Golf Tournament benefited 4 primary schools in counties **Leitrim** and **Mayo**. These schools each received a grant to be used for the development of science and literacy programs.

One of the grant recipients, St. Caillin's National School in County Leitrim, used the funds for library books and to purchase a new computer and color printer for their Learning Support Room. The 108 pupil school, 6 teacher school has experienced decreased enrollment over recent years, resulting in smaller grants from the Department of Education. This poses a serious challenge, as all maintenance and operational costs for the school have remained the same. Thus, the Partnership grant could not have come at a better time.


